I wish to thank you for giving me another opportunity to explain my case. I am a citizen of India bearing passport number J2160696 wishing to visit Ireland for further study. I have realized my management potential as a result of working in the corporate world for a decent period. If nurtured, these abilities could lead to numerous opportunities for growth for me. Training and development support will be all that I need to excel in my career. Management has today become even more versatile due to a combination of traditional practices and modern technology. Managers need to understand the business operations as well as how the divisions operate during my professional career. While I have great leadership skills and an aptitude for business management, my academic qualifications are limited to a basic master's degree.
